To change to a list \rightarrow Select "Manage Lists"



- ➔ Load custom list Select one of the options from the drop-down menu:
- Calumet Focal: Includes all 17 primary and secondary focal species* for the Calumet Region (Northwest Indiana and Northeast Illinois)
- Indiana Focal: should include all focal species* for the Indiana Marsh Bird project (southern region)
- Wetland Birds: Includes all the focal species* as well as other common bird species you may encounter at wetlands
- *IMPORTANT: There is a glitch with loading Common Gallinule using this website, please use other audio files for practice!
- → Select "Save and Exit"

If no species show up after selecting "Save and Exit," make sure you are in **Dendroica** (natureinstruct.org/dendroica). If you are in "Piranga," go back to the home page and select "Dendroica" NatureInstruct > Dendroica > USA > Manage Lists

Manage Lists

You can select lists of species to limit the species that you are studying based on geopolitical regions (the whole country, or an individual province, territory or state), Bird Conservation Regions (BCR), taxonomy or song types. You can also create your own customized lists to study particular groups of species.

The country, province and territory or state lists include all species known to have occurred in each region based on data in the Avibase database http://avibase.bsc-eoc.org/. By default, only those species that occur regularly in a region and which are known or believed to breed there will be displayed. To show non-breeding species or rare species, unselect the boxes above the lists.

Note that even if a species is on the list, it will not be shown if we lack photographs and sound recordings.

In some cases, changing a geopolitical list may change the selection or order of photographs or sound recordings presented for a species to emphasize plumages or dialects most likely be encountered in a particular region.

Note that if you select more than one list, your current species list will be restricted to only those species that appear in ALL of the active lists. If you select contradictory lists, you may en up with no species being displayed.

You may remove a list from your filters by setting the list selection box to the top option (---None---). If you select this option for the Geopolitical list, it will automatically refer to the most inclusive geographical region (the country).
